


Challenges In The Healthcare System Today



The Rising Cost of Healthcare







The Joint Commission





The Joint Commission

- 1965: Deemed the national accrediting organization
- 88% of hospitals



Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers Act (MIPPA)

- 2010: States may select acceptable accreditation bodies
- Accreditation Organizations (AOs)



The New Players

- Virginia
 - Accreditation Commission for Health Care, Inc. (ACHC)
 - Community Health Accreditation Program (CHAP)
 - Joint Commission for Accreditation of Health Care Organizations (JCAHO)



More than AOs

- CMS' oversight system
 - Accreditation Organizations (AOs)
 - State Regulators
 - Quality Improvement Organizations
- Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs)
 - Group of individual providers
 - Leverage economies of scale
 - Big initial expense to integrate systems
 - Significant cost savings over time (1)

(1) Of the 114 participating ACOs in 2012, 29 met the financial target, saving \$128 million and receiving \$126 million in bonus payments, according to CMS.
